This term, full time/part time RN Instructor position consists of 22 weeks of full time and 30 weeks of part time (21 hrs. per week) employment. If/where requested, job share opportunities will be considered. Anticipated Start Date: March 6, 2023

Roles & Responsibilities

As part of our dynamic and supportive team the primary role of the RN Instructor includes the planning, preparation and delivery of NS and Futureworx CCA Curriculum, as well as the direct and indirect supervision of learners during clinical placement, in a variety of care settings. Instructional areas within the program include but not limited to anatomy and physiology, nursing skills, terminology and documentation, dementia care, palliative care, interpersonal communication, and medications.

- Providing theoretical, laboratory and clinical instruction/supervision, in accordance with the Nova Scotia and Futureworx Continuing Care Assistant Curriculum
- Planning and preparing instructional materials and resources, which utilize a variety of teaching methods to promote student success
- Create an environment that is conducive to learning and student development, contributes to maintaining a healthy, secure, and safe learning environment.
- Maintain records of student attendance, grades, lab, and/or homework assignments.
- Building and sustaining professional relationships with students, colleagues, community partners, and other stakeholders
- Monitoring students' progress in the classroom and placement settings. Contribute to maintaining a healthy, secure, and safe learning environment.
- Provide 1:1 student performance counselling/feedback sessions and advise students regarding academic matters.
- Communicate collaboratively and pro-actively with internal and external program stakeholders
- Coordinate and monitor student work placements, as required
